Write out the names of all ten provinces and three territories, using their official names. Don't forget that the most easterly province is called "Newfoundland and Labrador", not just "Newfoundland." And neither Yukon nor Nunavut have the word Territory in their names, but Northwest Territories does, in the plural.

When you're done, count how many letters you needed to do that. The answer is remarkable: it takes 150 letters to spell the 10 provinces and 3 territories. That's a sesquicentennial tribute!
